

## **About Foundy Street**

#### Who We Are

Foundy Street is a collective – a group of different talents that didn't fit in anywhere else came together to create our own space, and shine a light on the coolest and most artistic place in the city of Asheville. Located within Asheville's River Arts District (RAD), the area is

indisputably Asheville's hottest spot for local culture. The RAD is home to over 200 artist studios, restaurants, breweries, music venues, two skateparks, a winery, and shops of all sorts.























#### **Our History**

The Foundy Street area has been a place of pioneers and makers for well over 100 years. Beginning in 1898, the buildings along Foundy Street originally housed the Hans Rees & Sons Tannery — the largest leather belt-making enterprise in America during that time. Rees invented the process for curing, tanning, and finishing cowhide belts that would be sold to turn high-powered transmissions. Asheville had an abundant supply of Chestnut Oak bark and clean, pure water from the French Broad; two necessary resources to cure the leathers.

The original property was comprised of 30 buildings on 22 acres between the French Broad River and the Southern Railway. They employed 3,000 local people and processed 30,000 pounds of cattle hide each day. The tannery was almost destroyed between two catastrophic events — first the flood of 1916, then a large fire in 1917. Many of the buildings were rebuilt in 1918 following the fire. Business remained strong until 1955, when the company was purchased and equipment relocated to Camden, NJ.





Beginning in the 1970s, artists began moving into many of the long-neglected Cone Denim industrial spaces (north of Foundy Street) throughout the River District - bringing on the dawn of what is now renowned as the River Arts District. However the tannery property on Foundy Street continued to sit unoccupied and declining until 2016 when a group of local Asheville investors began to dream about the potential of the property. They envisioned a vibrant and inspirational place where locals would want to hang out, and visitors could get the "true" Asheville experience. The warehouses were lightly restored, and the first anchor tenants began to move in - Wedge Brewing (it was their second location in the River Arts District) and 12 Bones BBQ (a relocation from their original site, which was famously adored by President Obama during his visits to Asheville). Other businesses began to follow including Summit Coffee, and Foundation Studios (woodworkers and artists).

Foundy Street celebrates counter-cultural art, allowing and inviting graffiti artists to make their mark on the property as a living, evolving canvas. There's always something new to see and experience.

What you experience today is the rebirth of Foundy Street through a collective community effort. It's a living, breathing place that belongs to all of us, and where all of us belong.





# Maps & Wayfinding

Foundy Street is a graffitied mecca of industrial buildings, located in the heart of the River Arts District. It is bordered by the French Broad River Greenway near Amboy Park, and I-240. It's just a few blocks from Downtown Asheville, South Slope Brewing District, Biltmore Village, and West Asheville. You'll know when you find it -- Foundy Street just hits differently.

From I-40 West: Take exit 50B to merge onto US-25 N/

Hendersonville Rd toward Asheville/
Biltmore Estate. Turn left onto All Souls
Crescent, then continue onto McDowell St.

Meadow Rd (which turns into Lyman St).

From I-26 East: From I-26 E, take the Patton Avenue exit

towards Downtown. Turn right onto Clingman Ave, then left onto Clingman Ave Extension. At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto Lyman St. Turn left onto Old Lyman St, then right onto Foundy St.

From I-26 West & AVL Airport:

From I-26 W / US-74W, take exit 1C for Amboy Rd and continue onto Amboy Rd. Turn left onto Lyman St, then right onto Old Lyman St, and then right onto Foundy St.


### **Aerial Map**



















